LETTER OF INTENT

between the

Leibniz Universität Hannover

and the

EuroMediterranean Progressive Policy Institute

The purpose of this letter is to promote co-operation in the fields of teaching and research between the **Jean Monnet European Center of Excellence at the Leibniz Universität Hannover** and the **EuroMediterranean Progressive Policy Institute (EMPPI)**.

Both Institutions agree to enter into negotiations on the following general forms of co-operation based on the EMPPI Brussels Dossier of November 2007:

1. Advanced Diploma in EuroMediterranean Studies (ADEMS)
2. Doctorate in EuroMediterranean Studies
3. Fellowship Award Program

The themes of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved and the arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be negotiated separately for each specific case by the interested parties.

It is understood that at this time **no financial commitments**, obligations, or payments can be made by the Leibniz Universität Hannover to this project. All further financial arrangements between the two Parties would be negotiated individually.

It is also understood that the implementation of any agreement will commence upon its signing by both parties, and that it will be valid for five years, subject to revision or modification by mutual consent. The possibility and terms of renewal of any agreement will be discussed by the representatives of both Parties within six months prior to its termination.
