The purpose of this letter is to promote co-operation in the fields of teaching and research between the Jean Monnet European Center of Excellence at the Leibniz Universität Hannover and the EuroMediterranean Progressive Policy Institute (EMPPI).

Both Institutions agree to enter into negotiations on the following general forms of cooperation based on the EMPPI Brussels Dossier of November 2007:
